



What will happen at your hearing test?



The Audiologist will look in your ears using a small torch.

The audiologist will:

- check that your ears are healthy.
- look for wax.
- look at your ear canal and your eardrum.



You might need to go to the nurse.

If your ears are blocked with wax the nurse will clear them.



You might have a hearing test.

You will put on headphones and listen to different sounds.



Listen carefully. Some of the sounds will be quiet. Some of the sounds will be loud.

When you hear a sound tell the audiologist.



The audiologist will draw the results from your hearing test onto an audiogram.



The audiologist will explain your test results to you, and tell you what will happen next.

If you have any questions you can ask the audiologist.
